For the loaf - 225g unsalted butter, 225g caster sugar, 4 eggs, 225g SF flour, 1 lemon zested

For the drizzle – 1.5 lemons juiced, 85g caster sugar

Method – beat butter & sugar then add eggs one at a time, add flour & lemon zest, place in a lined 2lb loaf tin.

Bake at 180 degrees C/160 degrees C Fan /Gas Mark 4 for 40-45 mins

For drizzle - mix juice and sugar, prick cake all over and pour over, leave to cool in the tin

CLASS 36 3 ROCK BUNS - to be made to the following recipe

225g SF flour, 75g caster sugar, 1tsp baking powder, 125g unsalted butter(cut into cubes), 150g dried fruit, 1 egg, 1tbsp milk, 2tsp vanilla extract

Method – mix flour, sugar and baking powder, rub in cubed butter, then mix in dried fruit

Beat egg, milk & vanilla extract together, add to the dry mixture, adding more milk a tsp at a time until the mixture comes together

Place spoonfuls of the mixture on to lined baking tray and bake at 180 degrees C/160 degrees C Fan /Gas Mark 4

CLASS 37 3 CHEESE & ONION ROLLS - to be made to the following recipe

1tbsp oil, 1 red onion – chopped, 2tsp brown sugar, 2 medium potatoes – peeled & diced, 250g cheese – grated, 2 tbsp plain flour, 320g puff pastry sheet, 1 large egg beaten, pinch of salt & pepper

Method – fry onions with oil & brown sugar, boil potatoes & lightly mash, mix ingredients together, saving some cheese for the tops, divide pastry sheet into 12 add filling down centre, brush edges with beaten egg, roll and place on lined baking tray, brush the tops with egg, bake for 15 minutes at 200 degrees C / 180 degrees fan / gas mark 6, remove and sprinkle over

Remaining cheese, return to the oven & bake for a further 15-20 mins
